Present: Emma Candy (CEC), Dong Giles, Sally Millar, Cllr Susan Rae

Consultation-hub

EC explained she had sent demos, Bruce has sent feedback.

EC gave demo, including a now-functional voting feature.

Options are non-linear (voters choose which pages they view, then whether to vote) or linear (from introduction, through project-pages, then to voting).

Each project-page currently has some info-gathering questions.

In the linear version, we could have 2 projects per page.

***thought - we might want to collect age-data

*** thought - we could have a separate thing for under-8s. (Not currently a priority.)

Don notes demos are text-heavy: logo should lead to short amount of text (with option to see more)

SM: accessibility options?

EC - depends if folk have assistive technology

EC - can add rich media, videos etc

SM - we have thought about getting projects to

SM - can we have text which is clicked and then read out?

BR - can the site be provided in other languages?

*** ACTION: EC to investigate these

EC - it's all GDPR-proof

SM - if forced to read all projects, questions on each project page may be a bit much. Can there be a semi-linear version?

EC - could make a drop-down with votes.

*** ACTION - Emma to try mocking up this 'escape-route' using the fact-bank functionality

DG - we have asked projects to send us photos illustrating/showcasing their projects. Can this be done easily?

EC - all sorts of rich media can be added. We just need to think about best use.

EC - hub changes presentation to be user-friendly according to users' devices

SM - is it GDPR-OK to collect email addresses?

EC - if we say why

SM - if they enter a fake postcode

EC - consult hub can tell if entry is in postcode format but can't automatically reject non-Leith postcodes.

Also Bruce says some folk may not know their postcodes. So we could not check for answers in postcode format.

(SM knows many folk didn't know their postcodes, but did know which street, so could refer to relevant list. So we could add 'if you don't know postcode, state your street.)

Elimination of ineligible can be done automatically?

EC confirms that this job is on their work-list

EC can add in facilities for boost-vote, after the main voting page

The radio-button option can't have the best-vote bit added in
